The meeting of Joint Review Committee of Condition Assessment and Management Plan project for Mahanadi River Basin was conducted at NIT Raipur with the agenda to review the progress of work carried out after the Memorandum of Agreement, dated 28.02.2024. Closing Remarks were given by NRCD.

In the meeting the following points were also discussed:

- 1. Consortium Institutes must make a dedicated website of cMahanadi.
- 2. All the data related to study must be aligned on GIS platform from starting onwards.
- 3. Consortium institutes are urged to designate team members for the formation of subject-specific expert groups.
- 4. Consortium institutes are required to conduct weekly meetings to evaluate the progress of tasks.
- 5. Consortium institutes are mandated to identify the sources for gathering secondary data necessary for all missions.
- 6. All the missions of the CAMP Project must be achieved within the allotted timeframe.
- 7. Committee suggested on prioritization of the prevailing issues at Mahanadi Basin from the available soft and hard copy of secondary data from the different government and private agencies.
- 8. Pollution abatement plans under Nirmal Dhara have been given more emphasize
- 9. Tasks and sub tusks under each mission should be delivered in time bound manner, at least monthly evaluation is required.
- 10. For each state i.e. Chhattisgarh and Odisha there will be separate nodal officer appointment for smooth data collection
- 11. NRC has given assurance to provide all possible support from their side to accelerate the work flow.
- 12. In association with River cGanga activities and plan the task force should also focus on Global River management activities and plan
- 13. Purchase procedure should be faster and follow the institute rule
- 14. Separate website should be developed to upload all the data and activities related to CAMP. PPTs and technical and financial progress reports should be uploaded in this website on time to time basis. These data will be available for all the committees including Technical Committee, Joint review Committee and Stakeholder advisory committee
- 15. IISC Bangalore has already developed some data storage system which need to be discussed and implemented if possible
- 16. Dr. Tanveer Ahamed and his team from WII Dehradun are working on Ecological status of Mahanadi. They can be consulted for this project also.

- 17. Separate office space should be dedicated for managing all activates related CAMP project
- 18. Special subject group experts should be suggested for creating subject groups in each mission
- 19. Each activity under CAMP project should be linked to social media including newspaper, website and other platform
- 20. Whole project data should be present in combined form i.e NIT Raipur and NIT Rourkela for each mission.
- 21. There will be a stakeholder's committee meeting to be held at Nagpur on 31st May, 2024. Project coordinators should be present in that meeting
